

Talent Spotting and Progression

Awareness and engagement across the different CD organisations and clubs to encourage and enable drivers with disabilities to participate in competitive CD leading to increased number of drivers with disabilities to join the talent pool. This includes rule changes, adaptations, compensatory aids, guidance

Development and Participation

Via local groups eg RDA, local clubs, individual coaches (from a range of sources and at different levels), input from other drivers and CDSGdd programme of events, clinics and online sessions

RDA

Drivers who are driving on single reins /independently and compete at Reg/Nat RDA CD events

Para Dressage

Existing Riders who can no longer participate in riding but wish to remain in an equine sport

Other Para Sports

Those already in para/disabled sports (probably no equine experience) – might also come via RDA

Individuals outside of any sport/group

Individuals with disabilities who sustain injury/illness and want to continue in equestrian sport

Typical sources of Carriage Drivers with disabilities who want to develop their sports driving skills and from which a pool(s) of drivers will emerge and drive/compete at local, regional, national, international level (including representing GB)
